Objective:

Gandhinagar Institute of Technology organized a celebration of Women’s day on 1st March, 2019 in lieu of International Women’s Day under the banner of Women Development Cell (WDC). The celebration was organized for the female students. It was a global day celebrating the social, economic, cultural and political achievements of women. The day also marked a call to action for accelerating gender parity. Program Overview:

She made the girls graceful by teaching various cardio forms as well as aerobics. She also taught the importance of workout in our lives. The second session comprised of rangoli competition and dance competition. The third session included the seminar on “Wonder women in civil services”. The chief guest for the day was Shri Neha Kumari, an IAS Officer in Gujarat Cadre. The session began with lamp lightening and a prayer song. A video clip was played on famous Women Personalities which gave an insight of inspiration for all the female students. It was followed by an inspirational speech by principal sir.
