“Parent Teacher Meeting 2019”

1st PTM-Even semester 2019 at a Glance:

Objective of the event:

The Parent Teacher Meeting for B.E. Semester 4, 6 & 8 was organized on 30/03/2019 to discuss about students' progress and performance at the institute. The goal was to build a healthy relationship with the students and parents. The parents were intimated about the meeting well in advance through network administrator and mentors.

Activities during the event:

The parents started reporting at the institute from 9 am onwards outside A-Block where a Welcome Desk was placed to guide them to cafeteria for refreshment. After that, parents were escorted to the respective department building for a formal interaction with the HOD.

During 10.00 am to 10.30 am, HODs introduced parents with the Vision and Mission of the institute and the departments along with anti-ragging rules, focus on quality education, library facilities and general criteria of the institute. They also highlighted the best practices followed by the institute for effective teaching learning process and how it help students in placement and for higher studies.

During 10.30 am to 12.00 pm, parents were directed to respective classrooms for one to one interaction with mentors and faculties. The parents were informed about the attendance criteria (75% according to GTU norms), students' performance during Mid Semester Exam and GTU examination. Discussion was focused on student's specific strengths and weaknesses in individual subjects and students discipline in classrooms, restricted mobile usage in classrooms, AMTS bus routes up to college gate. The suggestions from the parents about their wards' interests and learning were noted.

Outcomes of the event:

Around 63 parents participated in the 1st PTM of Even Semester 2018-19. Parents became aware about the rules and regulations of the institute, teaching learning methodologies and various activities going on for overall student welfare. There was one to one session between parents and student mentors for analyzing students' performance and steps necessary for the improvement of their wards' skills. Parents expressed their gratitude and enthusiasm for this interactive session with the faculties so that they can know better about their wards performance at the institute.

The PTM came to an end with the conclusion that the progress and development of the students depend on the joint efforts of parents and teachers. For this purpose, parents agreed to keep a close vigilance on the actions of their child, and to keep in constant touch with the mentors.
