**Introduction:**

NPTEL is an initiative by the IITs (IIT Bombay, Delhi, Guwahati, Kanpur, Kharagpur, Madras, and Roorkee) and IISc along with full financial support by MHRD. The main objective of the National Programme on Technology Enhanced Learning (NPTEL) is to enhance the quality of engineering and science education in the country by developing content for undergraduate and postgraduate curricula using video and web-based courses. These courses cover the syllabi prescribed by universities and approved by AICTE. - Final score calculation for certification
  - Online assignments: 25% + Proctored exam: 75%

**PASS CRITERIA: AVERAGE ASSIGNMENT SCORE  $\geq 10/25$  AND EXAM SCORE  $\geq 30/75$  AND FINAL SCORE  $\geq 40$**

- Types of certificates based on Final score
  - Elite + Gold certificate :  $\geq 90\%$
  - Elite + Silver certificate : 75 - 89%
  - Elite certificate:  $\geq 60\%$
  - Successful completion : 40 - 59%
  - No certificate < 40%
- Assignment Scores:
  - 4 weeks course: Best 3 out of 4 assignments
  - 8 weeks course: Best 6 out of 8 assignments
  - 12 weeks course: Best 8 out of 12 assignments

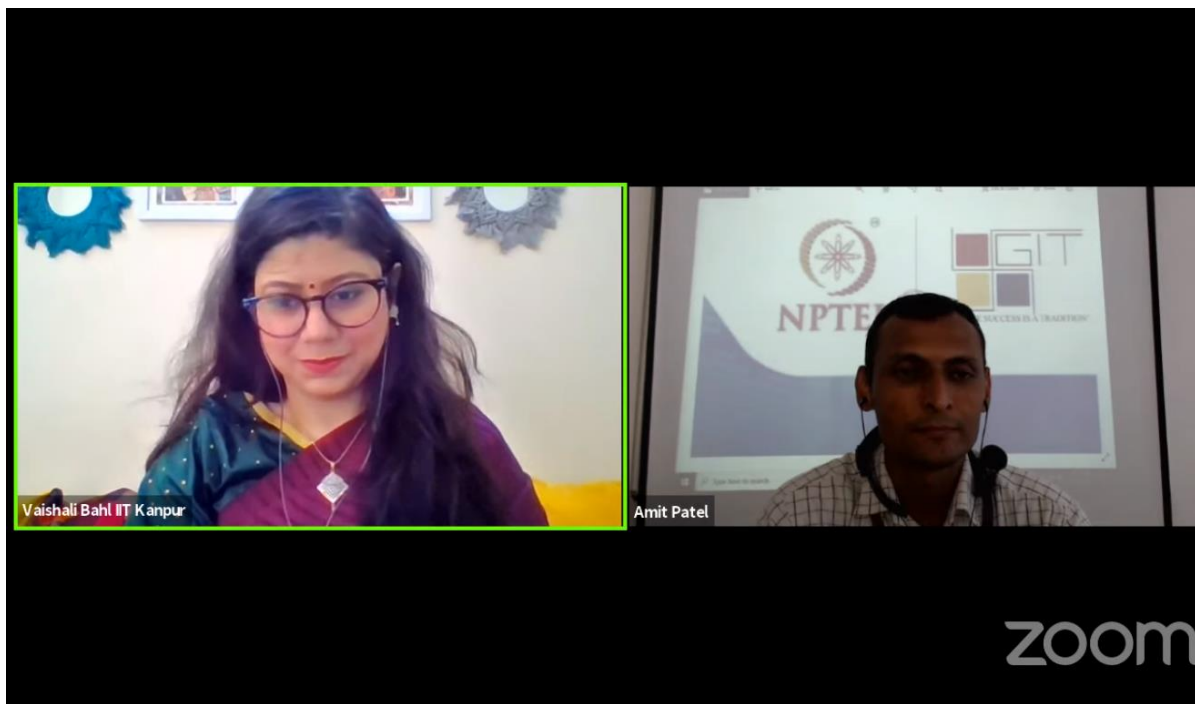
