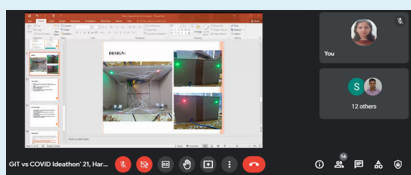
## INTERNATIONAL DAY AGAINST DRUG ABUSE AND ILLICIT TRAFFICKING

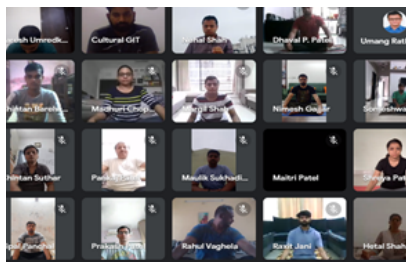
## NEW EDUCATION POLICY 2020

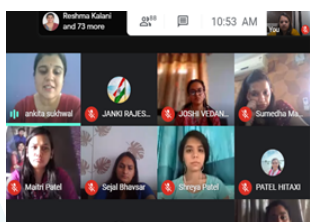


### INTERNATIONAL DAY OF YOGA

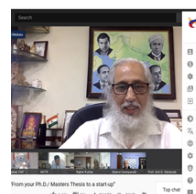
### NPTEL AWARENESS FOR STUDENTS AND FACULTIES OF GUJARAT



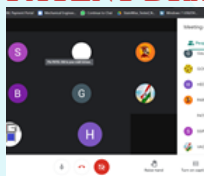

### PATENT DRAFTING FOR BEGINNERS



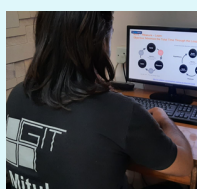
Gandhinagar Institute of Technology SSIP-IPR Cell organized a lecture series for students on the topic 'Patent Drafting for beginners: Claim Drafting Methods' on 12th April, 2021 to provide exposure to patent drafting for GIT engineering students. Prof Jyotin Kateshia, IPR Cell coordinator, discussed the methodology to draft patents. The patent can be searched on USPTO, WIPO, Indian patent office website, google patents etc. Thereafter, patentability criteria were discussed and the emphasis was also given on Novelty, non-obviousness and applications which are the most important criteria for patent filing.

### INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS AND PATENTS

GIT IPR, GIT SSIP, GIT IIC, and GIT IQAC have organized a two days GUJCOST sponsored national-level webinar on "Intellectual Property Rights and Patents" on 21st and 22nd of June, 2021, attended by Professors, Associate Professors, Assistant professors, Researchers, Engineering students from 39 institutions and universities across India. ## EXPERT LECTURES

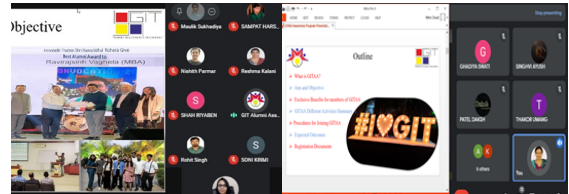
