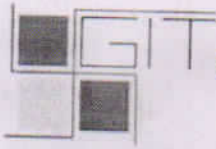

Agenda 2: Web page creation for NISP page.

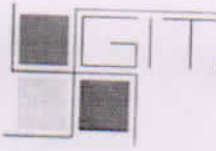
As per the requirement of NISP portal, the NISP convener discussed the importance of NISP web page and deliberated the contents to be published on the web page.
